TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES

January 15, 2018

The Thorntown Town Council met on January 15, 2018, at the Town Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Don Johnson.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present were Council members Don Johnson, John Shives, Mark Garing and Koren Gray.
