TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES  
JUNE 18, 2018

The Thorntown Town Council met on June 18, 2018, at the Town Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Don Johnson.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes: Koren moved to accept the minutes of June 4, 2018. This motion was seconded by Mark and passed 5-0.

#### OLD BUSINESS

Reserve Ordinance: Second and third reading. Mark moved to accept amendment to Reserve Ordinance to raise the maximum number of reserves from ten to fifteen. Motion seconded by Koren. Motion passed 5-0.

Noise Ordinance: Koren moved to approve amendments to Noise Ordinance concerning times and fireworks. Mark seconded the motion and it passed 5-0.

Second and third reading. Koren moved to accept the amended Noise Ordinance. Mark seconded this motion. Motion passed 5-0.

Building Regulations: Changes will be forwarded to Amy to write an amended ordinance.

Comp Time: Sheriff's Department officers cannot accumulate more than 16 hours and must be used in 90 days.

Koren-Comp time needs to be a legitimate business need.

Mark-Needs more than 16 hours.

Russ-Would like to see Lebanon policy adopted.
