

### COMMUNITY CROSSINGS

Since inception, **\$1.93 billion** has been awarded to cities, towns, and counties. Aim was instrumental in the creation of the program and provided guidance and support helping communities access nearly \$2 billion for road infrastructure.



### ARPA SUPPORT

Aim worked nationally to get direct Covid relief for cities and towns and provided clarity, training, and reporting support, ensuring municipalities could maximize the use of **\$5.65 billion** in federal funding from the American Rescue Plan Act.



### OPIOID SETTLEMENTS
