

**Town of Thorntown
Parks and Recreation Board Meeting

Business:

- The AARP grant proposal must be submitted by the deadline of Wednesday, March 5th. The \$11,000 grant, if awarded, will go toward remodeling the community and pollinator gardens.
- Sarabi Wallace is looking into writing another grant proposal to MIBOR. The grant, if awarded, will go toward a possible bike rental unit at the north trailhead. The grant proposal must be submitted by the deadline of Saturday, March 7th.
- The Eagles and Stalcorp will be sponsoring the Thorntown Farmers Market for \$450 each. Wright Gallery will be sponsoring Movie Nights in the Park for \$200.
- So far, 10 vendors have expressed serious intent in selling at the Thorntown Farmers Market.
- We are awaiting a quote from Merrill Construction concerning infrastructure, facility, and electric construction at the Lion's Park.
- The Lion's Park will not be renamed. Instead, Sarabi Wallace suggested that we install a plaque that reads, "Donated by the Lions and owned by the Town of Thorntown."

- Thorntown Parks and Recreation are now official members of the Boone County Chamber of Commerce.
- An agreement was made between the circus and Amy Nooning, town attorney, concerning the circus contract. We are waiting for the circus to return the signed contract.
- The FFA has expressed interest in volunteering for maintaining the community and pollinator gardens.


Adjournment:
