UTILITY SERVICE BOARD FOR THE TOWN OF THORNTOWN, INDIANA

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING
AN ADMINISTRATIVE FEE

WHEREAS, the Utility Service Board for Thorntown Utilities for the Town of Thorntown, Indiana ("Board") is the governing administrative body for Thorntown Utilities and has certain powers and duties under Indiana law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. 8-1.5-3-8 a municipality owning a utility shall furnish reasonably adequate services and facilities and pay the necessary expenses incident to the operation of the utility; and

WHEREAS, the Thorntown Utilities has experienced increased costs as a result of new development within the Town in the extension or upgrading of existing services to new users by the inspection, project management, and administrative costs associated with the service upgrades and extensions; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that they should adopt an "Administrative Fee" to defray the expenses of upgrading existing facilities and extending utility services by installing new lines and/or utility facilities for new development within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, The Board has determined that a fifteen percent (15%) "Administrative Fee" shall be added to the actual costs of the extension or upgrade of existing services to new customers to defray the expense of inspection, project management and administration of such activities.

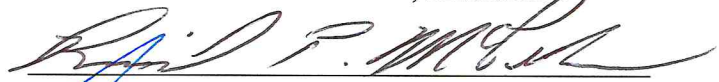
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE THORNTOWN UTILITY SERVICE BOARD, TOWN OF THORNTOWN, INDIANA, that pursuant to state law, the Board hereby imposes a fifteen percent (15%) Administrative Fee for the upgrade or extension of existing service lines or facilities to the actual cost, to defray the expense of inspection, project management and administration of the extensions or upgrades to existing facilities owned ~~the~~ ^{By} Thorntown Utilities.
